Directives for the nomination of Honorary Judges

European Gymnastics Honorary Judges

This award is based on a significant contribution to European Gymnastics as an international official over a long time.

Requirements:

- The award is based on a judgment without FIG sanctions during the designated period
- The judge must have judged at least one European Gymnastics event in at least three different Olympic cycles
- ART & RG: the judge must have judged at minimum 6 European Gymnastics events
- TRA, ACRO, AER, TG: the judge must have judged at minimum 4 European Gymnastics events
- Events taken into consideration are:
 - European Championships
 - European Age Group Competitions*
 - European Games
 - European Youth Olympic Festival.

The member Federations submit to the European Gymnastics office the name(s) of their judge(s) deserving this award between January 1st and February 28th of each year. A list of their judging assignments which shows that the above requirements were fulfilled and a copy of the logbook of the judges have to be included. After verification by the Sports Coordinator and the TC President, the General Director submits the request to the Executive Committee for final decision.

The judges concerned will receive an official diploma stipulating their title as "Honorary Judge of European Gymnastics" as well as the respective pin. These will be handed over in person to the judge concerned at the next European Gymnastics event of the discipline concerned or sent by post to the national federation.

The names will be published on the European Gymnastics website.

These Directives were approved by the European Gymnastics Executive Committee on September 10th, 2020 and will come into force immediately.
