European Gymnastics is pleased to herein provide you with the Directives for the 14th European Championships in Aerobic Gymnastics for Seniors and Juniors and the 1st European Under 15 Championships in Aerobic Gymnastics to be held in Ganja (AZE) from 9 – 16 November 2025.

These European Championships will be organised following the FIG & European Gymnastics Statutes and Technical Regulations (TR), AER Code of Points and relevant newsletters, FIG Code of Ethics, FIG Code of Conduct, FIG Code of Discipline, FIG General Judges Rules, FIG Specific Judges Rules, FIG Anti-Doping Rules, European Gymnastics Medical Guidelines, the Medical Organisation of FIG Competitions and Events, the FIG Framework for Safeguarding Athletes and other Participants from Harassment and abuse in Sport during Events, the FIG License Rules, European Gymnastics Media Rules, FIG Apparatus Norms, FIG Advertising and Publicity Rules, FIG Rules for Sanctioning (approval) of International Events, European Gymnastics Accreditation Directives, FIG Code of Ethics, FIG Code of Conduct, FIG Code of Discipline, Rules for Award Ceremonies as well as all other Rules and Guidelines valid starting 01 January 2025 onwards, any possible amendments by the date of these European Championships, and any complements decided in the meantime.

All participating Federations commit to abide by the Statutes and all European Gymnastics & FIG Rules and Regulations. Federations that fail to respect them will not be allowed to participate.

5. PARTICIPATION AND ACCREDITATION

Gymnasts holding a valid FIG licence until the end of the competitions, and with the correct age from European Gymnastics and FIG affiliated Federations in good standings, may take part in these European Championships.

An individual is entitled to only one accreditation card. If an individual has several valid “accreditable” functions, the highest function is normally selected and the access zones of the functions are cumulated. No substitutes may directly benefit from unused accreditations. The functions of judge cannot be combined with any other function.

An Individual Gymnast, a Mixed Pair, a Trio, a Group as well as an Aerobic Dance formation is considered a unit.

Accreditation Application Process

Each NF will be invited to log into the Smart Scoring Digital Platform where a section will be available to enter accreditation details and photo of each delegation member. All the details on how to access the portal and description of the application process will be provided to each NF by the LOC by email prior to the application process.

The photograph must follow the same requirements as for a passport:

- JPG format ONLY
- Be vertical orientation, in colour and not older than 6 months
- The background must be plain and light colour, preferably white
- Have adequate space between face/shoulders and the edges of the photograph
- Should have a minimum size of 100KB and maximum of 2MB

Details should be entered for all participants into the SmartScoring Digital Platform. This includes applications for accreditation of additional coaches, paramedical staff and guests for whom the NF will assume the participation costs, as described above.

Please consider: If photos will have to be taken at the accreditation desk (because they were not sent within the deadline/in the correct format) **EUR 50.-** will be charged for each photo.

All data submitted by NFs via the Smart Scoring platform are subject to the approval of European Gymnastics.

The European Gymnastics Accreditation Rules will be strictly applied, notably as far as the number of accreditations per federation is concerned. No further accreditations may be issued. Any additional person is considered a spectator and must buy entry tickets.

Accreditation cards will not be delivered unless all financial and insurance obligations have been successfully completed.

In addition, each NF **must also** register on the **European Gymnastics GymData Online registration system** by the stated entry deadlines for Definitive & Nominative entry (see Point 7).

International and local media representatives as well as federations' communication staff who are interested in covering the event can register online on [Media | European Gymnastics](#).

Deadline: November 2nd, 2025

The European Gymnastics Accreditation Directives and Media Rules have to be strictly respected.

6. AGE LIMIT OF GYMNASTS

Senior: 18 years old (born 2007) or older

Junior: 15 – 17 years old (born 2008, 2009, 2010)

Age Groups (U15): 12 – 14 years old (born 2011, 2012, 2013)

All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.

7. REGISTRATIONS AND ENTRY FEES

Registrations can only be made by European Gymnastics and FIG affiliated federations in good standing, via the **GymData Online registration tool** from SmartScoring (<http://registry.gymdata.online/>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations' login and password.

Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation until the following dates at the very latest:

All bank fees in connection with the bank transfer must be covered. Please state the name of the Federation and the payment purpose on the transfer (i.e. 'AZE _2025 AER ECH Registration Fees'). **The payment must be made in EUR only.**

Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards European Gymnastics or FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices etc.) and the LOC (e.g. hotel accommodation, meals) will not be allowed to participate in these European Championships.

In case of non-participation or partial participation the fee will not be reimbursed.

The sanctions are as follows as per European Gymnastics /TR:

8. LICENSES

No gymnasts, judges, coaches, and medical staff will be accredited without an **FIG licence valid until the end of the event.**

In order to be considered, licence application forms (new or renewal) must be submitted at least one (1) month prior to the deadline for nominative registration.

Please consult FIG License Rules for additional information in this respect.

9. JUDGES

The FIG brevetted judges are designated by their Federation and selected for the panels by draw, taking into consideration the degree of the brevet, according to the Judges' Rules.

If a federation does not enter a judge or comes with an insufficient number of judges, European Gymnastics, in line with the Technical Regulations, will request payment in the sum of EUR 2'000,- per missing judge.

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.

Judges shall recuse themselves if

- they are or were married to or live in a registered partnership or co-habit with a gymnast
- they are related to a gymnast by birth or marriage in direct or in collateral line, including the following persons: grandparent, parent, uncle, aunt, brother, sister, child, grandchild, nephew and cousin.

10. DRAWING OF LOTS

The gymnasts' drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the qualification competitions and the finals. It will take place on 28th August. No registrations can be accepted after the drawing of lots.

11. COMPETITION FORMAT

A competitor may compete in maximum 3 Aerobic categories and in only one age category.

Qualifications and finals will be carried out in each category and age group.

The 8 best per category (max. 1 per federation for GR, AD, resp. 2 for Individual Men, Individual Women, Mixed Pairs and Trios) may participate in the finals. The winners of the finals in each category are declared European Champions.

If there are less than 12 entries in a category, only 6 will proceed to the final.

To participate in the team ranking, federations must be represented in the qualification round with at least one participant in the following categories: Individual Men and/or Individual Women, Mixed Pair, Trio, Group and Aerobic Dance.

The team ranking list will be established by adding the 5 best places (rankings).

The Federation with the lowest total of ranking places will be declared European Team Champion. The FIG tie breaking rules will be applied.

12. EQUIPMENT

13. PUBLICITY

FIG advertising and publicity rules must be respected.

As the Code of Points foresee deductions should the FIG rules for Advertising and Publicity on attire and equipment not be respected, each Federation may fill in the online FIG Publicity form (FIG Rules for Advertising and Publicity Appendix E and F) if deemed necessary and send it to European Gymnastics by October 14th, 2025 at the very latest in order to have it approved.

While the Publicity Rule Chart is available on the FIG website under "Rules – Publicity" for additional information, you may also contact ldavila@europeangymnastics.com for further assistance if required.

14. VISA

Please verify immediately with your travel agent or Embassy or Consulate of Azerbaijan in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Azerbaijan. The LOC will assist you with a visa support letter provided that the request is made via email to shafiga.yolchuyeva@agf.az by October 14th, 2025 at the latest.

For those who are eligible to get e-visa (can be checked through this link: <https://evisa.gov.az/en/countries>), it is a responsibility of the Federations to get e-visa for their team members through this link:

It is not guaranteed by the LOC that the requests made after this deadline will be fulfilled.

15. TRANSPORTATION

The invited participating Federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their travel.

LOC will provide buses to Ganja **(free of charge)** for those delegations arriving in Baku.

Participating delegations will be transferred from Baku to Ganja either by train or by bus free of charge.

17. MEALS

Farewell Banquet

The place of the Farewell Banquet for the delegations will be confirmed in the Work Plan.

Accredited Delegation members (with the exception of E- and R- media), who will stay at one of the official hotels and will book their accommodation through the LOC will receive a free ticket for the Farewell Banquet.

All other persons wishing to attend the Banquet will be entitled to do so, provided that a request is sent to the LOC by emailing shafiga.volchuyeva@agf.az **until October 14, 2025**, requesting the number of tickets required. The cost of a ticket for the Farewell Banquet is EUR 50.-.

18. INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee, European Gymnastics and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The European Gymnastics and FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The FIG insurance IMSSA (International Medical & Security Sports Assistance) **for gymnasts and judges** with a valid FIG License / Brevet is valid for these European Championships. Please see further information on the FIG Intranet.

Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to <https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.

All other delegation members are NOT included in this insurance and must present a proof of insurance at the accreditation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy in English writing).

Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage will subsequently be offered with insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: **5 Euro** per person/day.

19. SAFEGUARDING

From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable.

The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.

In addition, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, the FIG campaign to raise awareness about youth protection in Gymnastics, will be displayed in several locations, including training and warm-up halls and public zones.

20. DOPING CONTROLS

Under the supervision of the International Testing Agency, anti-doping controls will be organized according to the valid WADA Code, International Standards and FIG Anti-Doping Rules. The anti-doping controls may take place at any time.

The music file shall be named as follows:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country)
- The first and last name of the individual competitor/s and the last name of MP, TR, GR AD, AS;
- The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AS, AD);
