SMARTSCORING

1. AIM

The UEG Development Programme has been established in order to help the UEG Member Federations to develop the gymnastics disciplines in their countries. The aim is to provide support for a long-term development.

2. FINANCIAL RESOURCES

The UEG Development Programme is financed by cash sponsoring from the UEG Global Partner SmartScoring as well as sponsoring of value in kinds from the UEG Pool of Apparatus Suppliers (consisting of the companies Janssen-Fritsen, Spieth Gymnastics, Gymnova, Eurotramp).

3. USE OF THE DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

A) UEG Member Federations can apply for **apparatus donations (incl. RG hand apparatus)**.

Furthermore, the Organising Committees of the European Championships in artistic gymnastics, rhythmic gymnastics, trampoline gymnastics, acrobatic gymnastics and aerobic gymnastics have the right to buy one defined set of apparatus with a discount of 80% from the list price of the respective apparatus supplier. The UEG office provides the details on what is included in one defined set.

B) UEG Member Federations can apply for **financial support of other projects**, especially for the **development of coaching and judging activities**.

4. APPLICATION FOR AND ALLOCATION OF THE UEG DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The allocation of the aid is decided by the UEG Executive Committee.

Unused funds can be transferred to the following year. Unused funds for other projects can be transferred to apparatus donations and vice versa.

For apparatus donations, which may include RG hand apparatus, as well as other projects the UEG Member Federations can hand in applications by sending the according form "Application for Apparatus Donations" or "Application for Project Support" as well as the attachments mentioned on the forms to the UEG office. **All deadlines for applications are listed in the appendix.**

For the allocation of one defined set of apparatus with a discount of 80% as described in article 3.A) the UEG office will contact the Local Organizing Committee following the signature of an event contract.

Decisions for aid will be decided in meetings of the UEG Executive Committee as per planned dates listed in the appendix.

5. CONDITIONS

By signing the application form the UEG Member Federation confirms to respect the following conditions.

Apparatus donations are only made in case an immediate use of the apparatus can be guaranteed. Facilities (= training halls) as well as an existing training programme must be available. A re-sale of apparatus received through the UEG Development Programme is forbidden.

A UEG Member Federation cannot receive an apparatus donation from the UEG Development Programme in the same year as well as two years following it has received an apparatus donation from FIG.

For apparatus donations UEG is only responsible for the donation of apparatus as confirmed by the UEG Executive Committee. Transportation, customs and any other additional costs involved for delivery and set-up have to be taken over in full by the UEG Member Federation. The organisational details for the delivery of the donation have to be arranged directly between the company from the UEG Pool of Apparatus Suppliers and the UEG Member Federation concerned.

For financial support for other projects UEG is only responsible for the payment of the amount as confirmed by the UEG Executive Committee. The responsibility to cover all additional costs for the project, which exceed the donation from UEG, as well as the organisational responsibility remains in full with the UEG Member Federation concerned.

For apparatus donations as well as for the financial support of other projects the UEG Member Federation has to send information as well as photos about the use of the aid to the UEG office.

UEG reserves the right to control on site how the donations are being used.

7. FINAL PROVISIONS

Any cases not settled in these regulations will be decided by the UEG Executive Committee.

These regulations were approved by the UEG Executive Committee at its meeting on June 30th 2018 and updated in the UEG Executive meeting on June 29th 2019. Their current version enters into force on June 29th 2019.
