All-Around Final Results

(A maximum number of 2 Gymnasts per NOC will be taken into consideration when determining the AAF Results)
Qualification for Mixed Team Final (MTF) and Apparatus Finals (AF)

Each National Olympic Committee can enter a maximum of 3 gymnasts.

A maximum of 3 gymnasts can compete on each apparatus with the 2 best scores on each apparatus counting towards the Team Total.

MAG and WAG Mixed Team Final (MTF)

One (1) Male & One (1) Female Gymnast from each NOC.

The scores of the highest ranked AA Male gymnast on FX, PB & HB **PLUS** the highest ranked AA Female gymnast on VT, BB & FX from the QC will be added together to determine the Total Mixed Team Result for each NOC.

Qualification is by **NAME** and not by NOC.

The Best 16 Mixed Teams will qualify from the QC for the Mixed Team Final

MAG and WAG AF

Day 1 - MAG (FX, PH and SR) **and** WAG (VT and UB)

Day 2 - MAG (VT, PB and HB) **and** WAG (BB and FX)

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts on each apparatus from the Qualifying Competition will qualify for the respective Apparatus Final.

A maximum number of 2 Gymnasts per NOC are permitted in each Apparatus Final.

3 reserve gymnasts will be named on each Apparatus for each Final.








3.1 Qualifying Competition (QC)

The starting order for the Qualification Competition is made in accordance with the drawing of lots carried out at the Chefs de Mission Seminar on 20th April 2023 in Maribor.





If a NOC reduces the number of participating gymnasts or apparatus after the Long & Short List deadlines, the European Gymnastics TDs have the right to modify the Starting Order so as to ensure the best possible running of the competition. All information about the modification of the Starting Order will be advised during the Team Leader Meeting / Orientation Meeting.

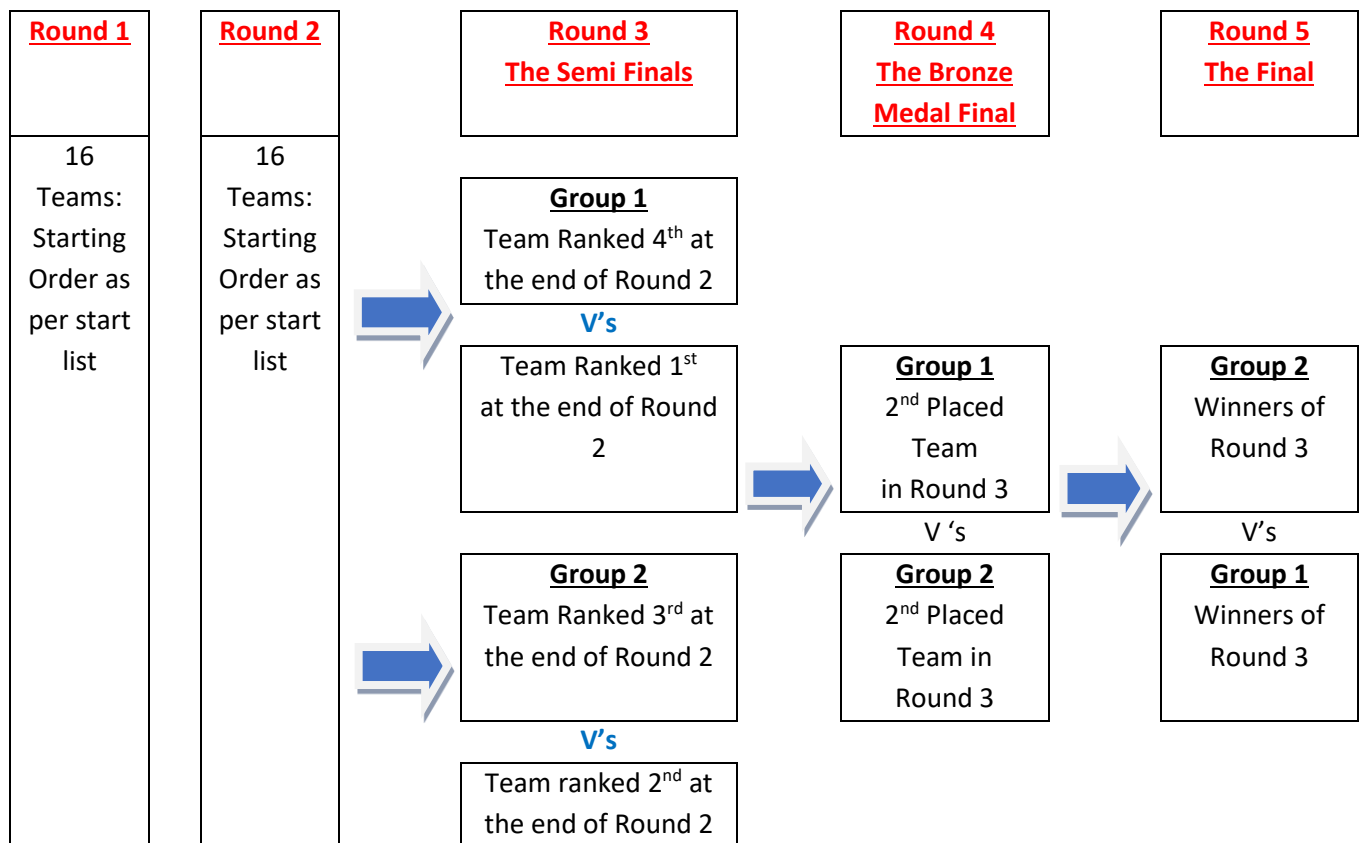

3.2 Mixed Team Final (MTF)



Round 1 and 2 – Qualification

- MAG & WAG Gymnasts will compete independently of each other in Rounds 1 & 2.
- Gymnasts can choose the order on which they compete on the relevant Apparatus, for example:
 - o A WAG gymnast may decide to compete on Beam in Round 1 and chose to compete on Vault in Round 2
- All NOCs who have qualified for the MTF, should complete **Appendix 11** “Confirmation of the Starting Order of Apparatus – Mixed Team Final EYOF”, for all **5 Rounds** and submit it to the LOC Information Desk **by 10.00 am on the morning of the Competition** for the attention of:
 - o For the MAG competition to Mr. James MAY, the MAG Technical Delegate
 - o For the WAG competition to Mrs. Christine FRAUENKNECHT, the WAG Technical Delegate
- An Apparatus cannot be repeated in Round 1 or Round 2
- If a WAG Gymnast chooses to compete on Vault in either Round 1 or Round 2 – Only 1 Vault is required.
- At the end of Round 2, the 4 Mixed Teams with the **Highest Total Score** will qualify for “Round 3 – The Semi Finals”.

Round 3 – Semi Finals

- Group 1 will comprise of the Teams ranked 3rd & 2nd at the end of Round 2.
- Group 2 will comprise of the Teams ranked 4th & 1st at the end of Round 2
- No Scores are carried forward from Rounds 1 & 2 (All Mixed Teams start from “0”)
- In Round 3, gymnasts must compete on the Apparatus on which they have not yet competed.
- The Starting Order in “Round 3 – The Semi Finals” is as follows:

Ranking after Round 2	Starting Order in Round 3
3	1 st – WAG followed by MAG
2	2 nd – WAG followed by MAG
4	3 rd – WAG followed by MAG
1	4 th – WAG followed by MAG

At the end of Round 3:

- The 2nd placed Mixed Team in Group 1 will compete against the 2nd placed Mixed Team in Group 2 in “Round 4 – The Bronze Medal Final”.
- The Winners of Group 1 will compete against the Winners of Group 2 in “Round 5 – The Final”.

Round 4 – The Bronze Medal Final

- This Round will decide the winners of the Bronze Medal.
- No scores are carried forward from Round 3 (All Mixed Teams start from “0”).
- The gymnasts can choose freely which apparatus they would like to compete on.
- If a WAG Gymnast chooses to compete on Vault in Round 4 – 2 Vaults are required with Junior Rules applying.
- The Starting Order in “Round 4 – The Bronze Medal Final” is as follows:

	Starting Order in Round 4 The Bronze Medal Final
Group 1 – 2 nd placed MT after Round 3	1 st – WAG followed by MAG
Group 2 – 2 nd placed MT after Round 3	2 nd – WAG followed by MAG

- The Mixed Team with the **Highest Total Score** at the end of Round 4 will determine the winner of the Bronze Medal.

Round 5 – The Final

- This Round will decide the Silver & Gold Medal Winners.
- No scores are carried forward from Round 3 (All Mixed Teams start from “0”).
- The gymnasts can choose freely which apparatus they would like to compete on.
- If a WAG Gymnast chooses to compete on Vault in Round 5 – 2 Vaults are required with Junior Rules applying.
- The Starting Order in “Round 5 – The Final” is as follows:

	Starting Order in Round 5 The Final
Group 2 – Winner	1 st – MAG followed by WAG
Group 1 – Winner	2 nd – MAG followed by WAG

- The Mixed Team with the **Highest Total Score** at the end of Round 5 will determine the ranking for Silver & Gold Medals.

MTF Tie Break Rules






- In case of a tie in points at any place to qualify for, or during the Mixed Team Final, the tie breaking rules will follow the principles set out for a Team Competition in the FIG Technical Regulations.
- If for medical reasons, the best ranked AA Female (on 3 apparatus) / AA Male Gymnast (on 3 apparatus) from the QC withdraws, the second ranked gymnast from the NOC can only replace her / him, if the new Total Score is higher than that of the NOC in 1st Reserve.
- All withdrawals should be submitted via the Sports Information Desk using **Appendix 7**, for the attention of:
 - o For the MAG competition to Mr. James MAY, the MAG Technical Delegate
 - o For the WAG competition to Mrs. Christine FRAUENKNECHT, the WAG Technical Delegate

3.3 Apparatus Finals (AF)






The Apparatus Finals will take place over two (2) Days.

The starting order for the Apparatus Finals is in accordance with the draw carried out at the Chefs de Mission Seminar on 20th April 2023 in Maribor. The order of Apparatus & Award Ceremony is detailed below:

If more than 8 gymnasts qualify for the Apparatus Final, another drawing of lots will take place, to reflect the number of qualified gymnasts.

3.4 Changes to the Starting Order – Apparatus Finals

If a qualified gymnast is unable to take part in the AF Competition, then they can be replaced by the next gymnast from their NOC, on the condition that their result is better than that of the first reserve. This new gymnast will take the starting position of the gymnast they replace.

Withdrawals / replacements of gymnasts for medical reasons will be accepted provided that the above-mentioned conditions are met. They are to be submitted using **Appendix 7**, via the Sport Information Desk for the attention of:

- o For the MAG competition to Mr. James MAY, the MAG Technical Delegate
- o For the WAG competition to Mrs. Christine FRAUENKNECHT, the WAG Technical Delegate

If a gymnast competes in two (or more) successive Apparatus Finals and medals in the preceding Final (thus reducing the gymnasts' opportunity to return to the warm-up hall prior to the next Final), the TD will adjust the start order, if necessary

3.5 Tie Breaking Rules

In the event of a tie in any place in the Team Ranking, the All-Around Ranking and in the Apparatus Finals, the tie breaking rules will follow the principles set for the Junior World Championships, Articles 5.3 of the FIG Technical Regulations. Ties will not be broken

3.6 Touch Warm-up during the Competition

Warm-up times according to the FIG rules:

- The general warm-up will take place in the warm-up hall.
- A touch warm-up will be permitted in the QC, MTF & AF on the Podium
- For Apparatus Finals, the gymnasts will be permitted to train on the Podium in the Competition Hall prior to the commencement of the Apparatus Finals Competition, on Friday and on Saturday. This warm-up will end 30 minutes before the start of the competition.
- In Apparatus Finals, the first 4 gymnasts will warm-up and compete followed by the remaining 4 gymnasts' warming-up and competing.

3.7 Access to the Competition Area

The competition area is accessible to members of the various juries, competing gymnasts and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the official doctor, to the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus as well as the LOC personnel.

Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the Technical Delegate.

The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.

Gymnasts are permitted to return to the warm-up hall during Podium Training & / Competitions, without any special approval, in order to share the designated stretching area and the apparatus. Priority will nevertheless always be given to any gymnast's warming-up for the following subdivision. Therefore, permission will be required from any NOC(s) warming-up on the Apparatus before the gymnasts coming from the Competition Hall may use a specific apparatus. Gymnasts will be fully responsible to return to the competition hall when required in order to perform their routine on time.

Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical team on the podium, the following provisions will apply:

- For full Teams in the QC (2-3 gymnasts), 2 coaches are allowed (WAG – 1 must be female)
- For NOC's with Individual Gymnasts in the QC, **ONLY** 1 coach is allowed (WAG – Male / Female)
- For NOC's with gymnasts in the MTF, 1 coach per gymnast is allowed (WAG – Male / Female)
- For NOC's with Individual Gymnasts in the AF, 1 coach per gymnast is allowed (WAG - Male / Female).
- For all competitions, 1 team medical person per discipline and per National Federation is allowed

3.8 Use of Electronic Communication Devices

During the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions (which is defined as starting the moment the first gymnast enters the field of play and ending the moment the last score is publicly displayed):

- Judges on the field of play are absolutely prohibited from using cellular phones / tablets and any other kind of electronic communication devices.
- Other delegation members (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff) are prohibited from using cellular phones and any other kind of electronic communication devices. However, gymnasts are allowed to listen to music (with earphones and on a sound level which is not observable for surrounding persons). It is also allowed for other delegation members to take photos (but no videos), without flash and not interrupting the running of the competition.
- If these rules are violated, the persons concerned will receive a verbal warning.
- If this behaviour is repeated after a written warning is issued, those persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition.
- The Superior Jury is responsible for deciding these disciplinary measures and their decision is Final.

3.9 Award Ceremonies

The ceremonies take place immediately after the competition in the competition venue.

- For Team Competition – Teams in the first 3 places on the Podium
- For All-Around Competition – Gymnasts in the first 3 places on the Podium
- For Mixed Team Competition – Teams in the first 3 places on the Podium
- For Apparatus Finals – Gymnasts in the first 3 places on the Podium

In accordance with the FIG TR, gymnasts are requested to wear NOC tracksuit during the Award Ceremonies.

3.10 Apparatus Supplier

The apparatus supplier is Spieth.

Additional landing mats for all apparatus will be provided by the apparatus supplier in the warm-up halls and for podium training. In addition, the Federations can bring small protection mats / pads / coverings only. These mats / pads / coverings (e.g. carpet mats, beam protection pad) must not be thicker than 5cm and not bigger than 1.50m x 1m. These mats / pads / coverings can be used during (podium) training but not for the touch warm up.

3.11 Scoring and distribution of Results

After each competition, the results will be provided on the official websites of the EYOF.

All lists and results will be available on the Mobile Application and will also be sent via E-mail and WhatsApp Group to the Delegation Representatives (contact info of the Delegations' Representatives will be collected at the Sport Information Desk).

Scoring will be carried out by Smart Scoring. A Video Control system will be provided.

At the end of the EYOF, the results book including the Judges' individual scores for all competitions will be sent by e-mail to the Delegation Representatives.

3.12 Team Leader Meeting / Orientation Meeting

The presence of the participating NOC at the Team Leader Meeting / Orientation Meeting is mandatory. A maximum of 2 members per NOC per discipline is permitted.

3.13 Competition Numbers

The competition numbers (bib numbers) will be provided to the NOC at the end of the Team Leader Meeting / Orientation Meeting. The numbers are to be firmly attached to the competition attire throughout the entire competition.

3.14 Written exercises (WAG only)

Submission of the gymnasts' routines in symbol notation is optional (to be emailed or directly given to Mrs. Christine FRAUENKNECHT, the WAG Technical Delegate christine.frauenknecht@bluewin.ch)

3.15 New Elements

New elements should be submitted as soon as possible by email to the President of the Superior Jury, but no later than 24 hours before the commencement of Podium Training. A technical drawing and a video must be attached to the e-mail.

Any close family relative to a competitive gymnast may not judge that gymnast or his / her unit (pair, group, etc.) at any FIG sanctioned event.





4.2.2 E-Jury

The E judges will be decided by the drawing of lots on site.

The E-jury for the QC consists of four (4) E-Judges. The final E-score will be determined from the average of the two middle scores.

The E-jury for MTF & AF will consist of five (5) E-Judges. The Final E-score will be determined from the average of the three middle scores.

All entered judges must be available until the drawing of lots for the last competition of the respective EYOF.

For AF, a NOC whose gymnast has qualified for an Apparatus Final (including 1st Reserve) will as a result, not have their judge included in the Judges Draw for the concerned Apparatus.

Cat 4 judges, if present, are only allowed to judge line and time.

As a reminder and according to the European Gymnastics / TR, the function of a Judge cannot be combined with any other function.

E-judges are only permitted to attend the Training sessions of their NOC's.

4.3 Judges' Instruction and Drawing of Lots

According to the European Gymnastics / TR, the presence of the judges at the judges' instruction is mandatory. The judges' instruction will be held in English.

The Judges' Oath will be carried out at the end of the Judges' Instruction, by one of the host NOC's Judges.

4.4 Inquiries of the Score

European Gymnastics applies the relevant TR/FIG Article.

The detailed procedure is laid down in the Technical Regulations of the FIG.

If the inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD), at a later date and must be paid within one month.

5 THE ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

5.1 Training information

According to the Training Schedules.

5.2 Official Podium Training

A detailed program of the official Podium Training will be provided to the participating NOCs.

The presence of the D-judges at Podium Training is mandatory.

The presence of E-judges at the official podium training is not mandatory, however, the MTC and WTC strongly encourage all E-Judges to be present.

When attending Podium Training the E-Judges can either sit in the stands or on the FOP.

5.3 Delegations

Each National Federation with 1 or more gymnasts may propose 1 judge to European Gymnastics for approval and nomination.

The Judges must fulfil the requirements of the FIG/TC. All Judges must be holders of a valid FIG Judges Brevet.

In case there are insufficient numbers of judges from the participating present NOCs, the Technical Delegates and the Organizing Committee will appoint the necessary number of judges.

In case there are too many judges proposed, the Technical Delegates will select those judges to judge at the event.

Gymnasts who do not have the correct age and a valid FIG license (or the validity of the license has expired) are not allowed to compete. All gymnasts' licenses will be checked by the LOC after receipt of the Long & Short list nominative inscriptions.

The 16th European Youth Olympic Festival for Men and Women, Maribor (SLO) 2023, will take place under the following current regulations:

- FIG General Judges' Rules

- FIG CoP modifications for Junior Competitions, and relevant Newsletters and Help Desk (WAG)
- The Artistic Gymnastics Technical Manual
- The Artistic Gymnastics Work Plan
- Rules of the World Anti-Doping Code shall apply in accordance with instructions of the EOC
- FIG Licence rules
- FIG Apparatus Norms
- FIG Rules for Sanctioning (approval) of International Events
- The advertising rules of the EYOF Charter overrule the FIG Advertising rules and subsequent decisions of the FIG and European Gymnastics Executive Committee

5.5 Sport Information Desk

Mailboxes will be set up at the Sport Information Desk at the competition venue, where the delegation members can find all the necessary information.

No hard copies of any documents (start list, results etc.) will be available for distribution.

All documents will be sent by e-mail to the responsible person from each delegation provided that the correct e-mail address was submitted to the Sport Information Desk.

The relevant documents will also be available on the mobile application. The LOC will distribute log-in details to the Delegation's Responsible Representative to access the application concerned.

All the necessary information will also be communicated via WhatsApp group (mobile phone numbers of the Delegations' Responsible Representatives will be collected for this purpose).
