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Note – Synchronised Qualification:

If needed, the Host NOC’s pair will replace the NOC’s pair qualified as 8th in the Synchronised event.

Note – Individual Qualification:

Individuals representing NOCs, qualified from the Synchronised qualification (places 1-16), are NOT taken into consideration for the Individual qualification (places 17-24).

If needed, the Host NOC’s athlete will replace the NOC’s athlete qualified as 8th in the Individual qualification.
