MUNICH – A MODERN CITY WITH TRADITION

The history of Munich is documented all the way back to 1158 when it was first mentioned as “forum apud Munichen”. The Old German name means “by the monks” and derives from the monks who ran a monastery at the place that was to become the Old Town of Munich. A monk is still depicted on the city’s coat of arms.

Today, the Bavarian state capital is the third-largest city in Germany – behind Berlin and Hamburg – and one of the most prosperous and fastest-growing cities in the country. It is consistently voted as one of Germany’s most liveable cities, with various career opportunities, a low crime rate, a broad selection of leisure and recreational activities plus an efficient infrastructure ensuring a high quality of life.

A METROPOLIS WITH SMALL-TOWN CHARM

Munich has become a household name around the globe in various sectors, be it art, science, technology,

education, or sports. The city houses many world-known brands, such as BMW, Siemens, Allianz, and FC Bayern Munich. There is a broad range of culture to be experienced in the 47 theatres and 46 museums, including the renowned Pinakotheken and the world’s largest technology museum, Deutsches Museum.

Till this day no building is allowed to be taller than the spires of the Frauenkirche (Cathedral Church of Our Lady), which unknowingly ensures that Munich does not feel as overwhelming as other cities of its scale. Various other factors add to the cosy vibe, from the city’s parks to Bavaria’s southern charm and famed beer culture. While the Oktoberfest nowadays often pictures a cliché, it is deeply rooted in tradition. When Crown Prince Ludwig married Princess Therese of Saxony-Hildburghausen in 1810, the citizens of Munich were invited to attend the festivities held in front of the city’s gates, with horse races marking the close of the

royal event. To honour their marriage the first Oktoberfest was held the following year and it has grown to what we see now over the centuries.

GATEWAY TO THE ALPS

Besides its touristic attractions, Munich boasts numerous green spots, with the English Garden alone covering 375 hectares! The Eisbach wave at its southern edge is probably the most famous river surfing spot and used by surfers throughout the year. With a length of 13.7 kilometres, the Isar winds its way through the city and offers additional recreational activities on its banks.

With its central European location and proximity to the Alps, Munich is the perfect destination for both city and nature lovers. The picturesque lakes and mountains are just a short drive away and provide the perfect setting for a weekend getaway.

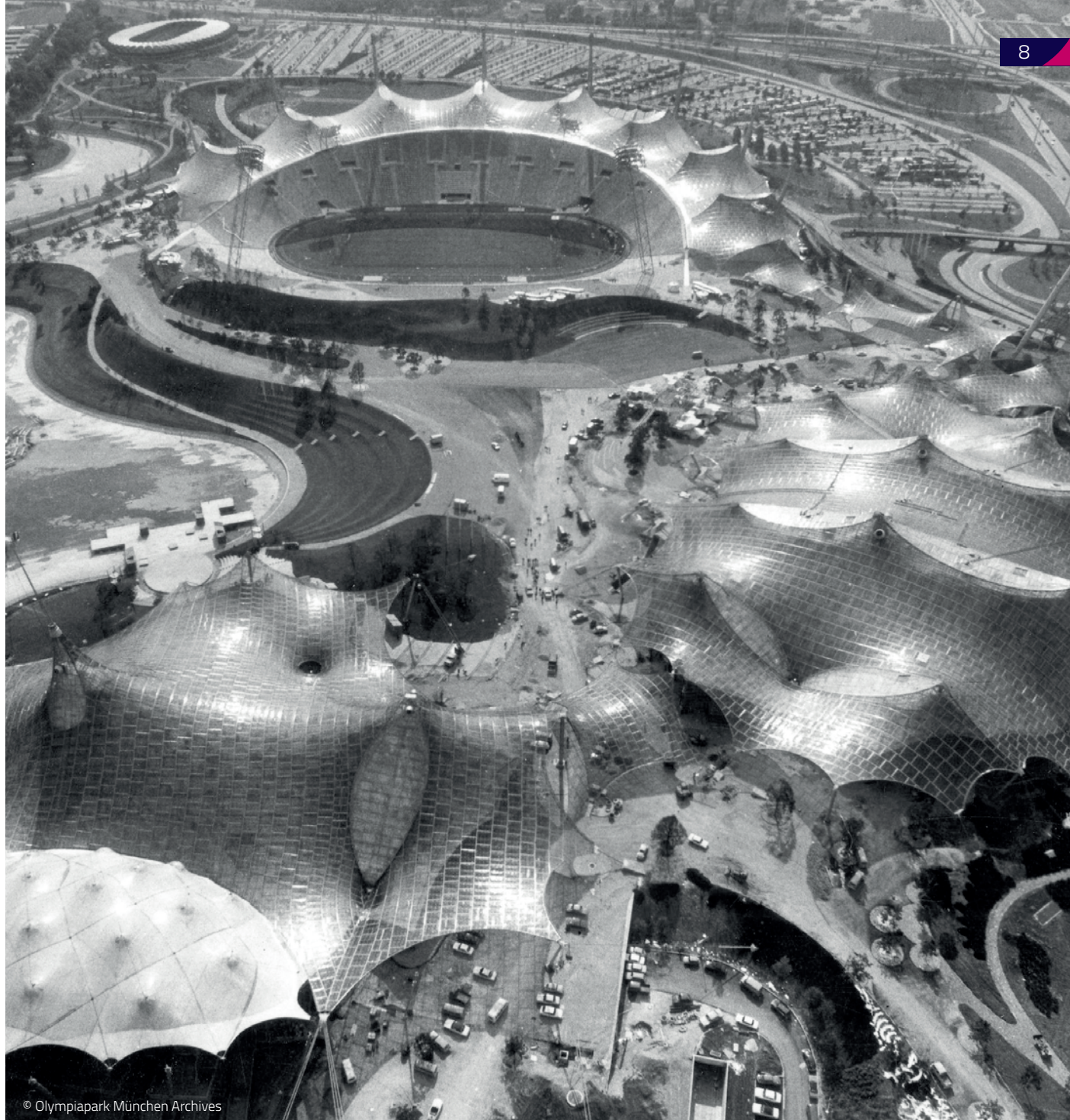

BACK TO THE ROOFS

Olympiapark München is an event location and meeting point with a glorious past, a vibrant present and a bright future. In August 2022, the park will once again be in the spotlight: By hosting the European Championships Munich 2022, Munich will welcome the largest sporting event since the 1972 Summer Olympics. High-profile sports 'under one roof', right in the heart of the city, in a carefree atmosphere – such is the winning formula for a unique and memorable experience. Back then, just as it is today.

Munich 2022 is an innovative return to the roots of the 1972 Olympic Games. A reminiscence of hospitality, happiness, and community, but also of the victims of the terrorist attack on the Israeli Olympic team. At the same time, the event is a return to a unique and historic place. It is a return to the legendary architecture of Olympiapark with its world-famous tent roof construction, which once turned Munich, seen as a village housing a million people, into an international sports metropolis overnight.

Munich 2022 pays homage to this heritage, celebrates the uniqueness of Munich as a venue, sets an example in terms of sustainability and leaves its own legacy. This is another, but certainly not the last chapter in the success story of Olympiapark.

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

Munich 2022 is more than just facts, figures, and sporting results. It is a holistic event experience, creating lasting memories in a light-hearted atmosphere. "The Roofs – Festival of Munich 2022" will significantly contribute to the eleven-day extravaganza. The festival of diversity and surprises will be accompanying the European Championships with a mix of music, culture, art, food and much more. It will turn Munich into the summer's place to be, with plenty on offer for young and old alike.

"The Roofs" is a festival for everyone. A place of encounter, participation, wonder and experience. Surrounded by the frenzy of the sporting competitions and accompanied by the charm and diversity of the regional culture.

The concept of pop-up experiences is creating a novelty setup and setting the stage – literally and figuratively – for the unexpected. The traditional event setup with the bundling of theme-specific contents in the same area is rearranged for “The Roofs”. Individually themed worlds – “Roofs” – will be created, each with their own character in terms of content and design. They will be spread across Olympiapark, Königsplatz and the Olympic Regatta Centre, allowing visitors and participants to

revel in a total of nine individual "Roofs" and delve into extraordinary experiences.

The programme is a tribute to 50 years of Olympiapark and symbolises the variety of this unique location, its history, present, and future. "The Roofs" conveys a small-town charm rather than giantism and focuses on uniqueness rather than uniformity. More to come. More to experience.

UNDER THE ROOF WHERE THE SPARROW FROM MINSK SOARED

No one shone brighter or soared higher than Olga Korbut at the Munich Olympics 50 years ago, with the Minsk native taking home three gold medals and one silver medal in the very venue that will now fittingly host the 2022 European Senior and Junior Artistic Gymnastics Championships.

Since its golden debut in 1972, Olympiahalle has continued to shine bright as Munich's biggest indoor hall, regularly hosting major sporting events such as the IIHF Ice Hockey World Championship final in 1975, the 1993 European Basketball Championship and the IHF World Handball Championship in 2019. These events have taken place alongside annual concerts from the likes of Tina Turner, Beyonce, Eric Clapton and Metallica.

Now, top-level gymnastics returns to Olympiahalle for the first time since stealing the Olympic spotlight half a century prior. Gymnasts will be welcomed by the same distinctive original façade but once inside, they will be treated to up-to-date amenities and the infrastructure required to host world-class events. Its high-arched ceilings and ample floor space allow for perfect execution in front of up to 9,000 spectators.

Olympiahalle makes up part of the wider Olympiapark – a multi-purpose park in Munich's north-west which consists of a multitude of venues, public areas and sporting facilities. 50 years on from its unveiling, Olympiapark remains a beloved destination for Munich

locals and tourists alike, receiving significant foot traffic on a daily basis. Olympiapark can be easily accessed from Munich's city centre by a variety of public transportation options.

The gymnastics programme at Munich 2022 takes place just metres from the athletics programme, triathlon, The Roofs festival, and a number of cycling events, placing it at the centre of the eleven-day sporting and cultural programme.

All that remains to be seen is, which gymnast will be the next to create their legacy inside the famed walls of Olympiahalle?

SPORTS & COMPETITION

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATIONS

All federations are entitled to participate with either a team composed of 3 to 5 gymnasts, or a maximum of 2 individual gymnasts. Please note that for the European Championships 2022 in Munich exceptionally, it will not yet be possible for MAG delegations to bring one further individual Senior apparatus specialist gymnast.

To support the TV production for the All-Around medal event and to allow some best places for top-ranked National Federations in the last subdivision on the seniors' MAG & WAG qualification days, the Seniors' draw will start with the 6 MAG and 4 WAG highest ranked European teams from the qualification competition at the Tokyo Olympic Games, drawn in the final subdivision

and placed horizontally across the apparatus working in Olympic order.

Beginning of next year, the Member Federations will receive the detailed Event Directives for the MAG and the WAG European Championships 2022 in Munich, including all event related information as usual.

MUNICH 2022 EMS

With the Event Management System (EMS) the LOC offers its users a platform to manage the various services around the event in one place and in an easy and efficient way. The EMS will open in February 2022.

Each National Federation will be provided with a login to manage Accommodation and Arrivals & Departures data for their delegation in the Munich 2022 EMS.

For media a link will be provided for entering the system. Everybody belonging to the media group has to register themselves to get an accreditation.

Please note that the LOC will provide User Guides with a step-by-step outline of the registration and booking processes before the opening of the system.

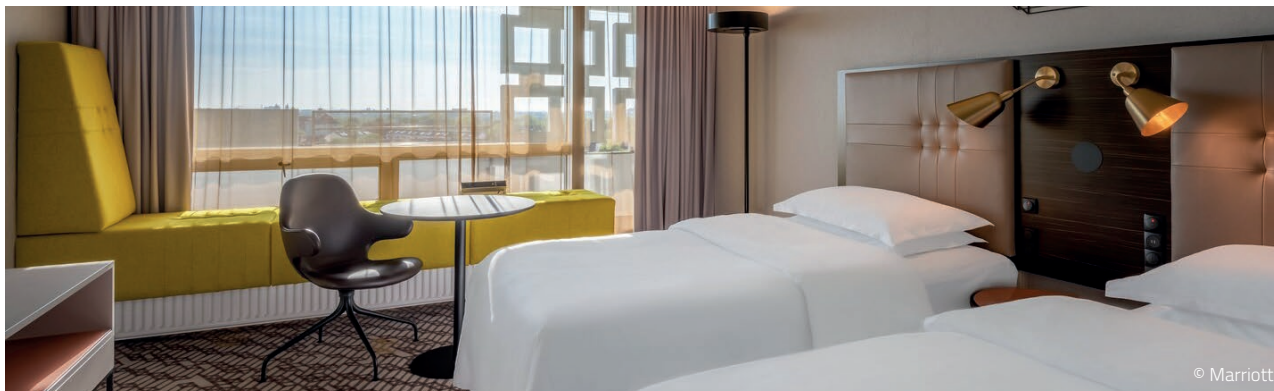

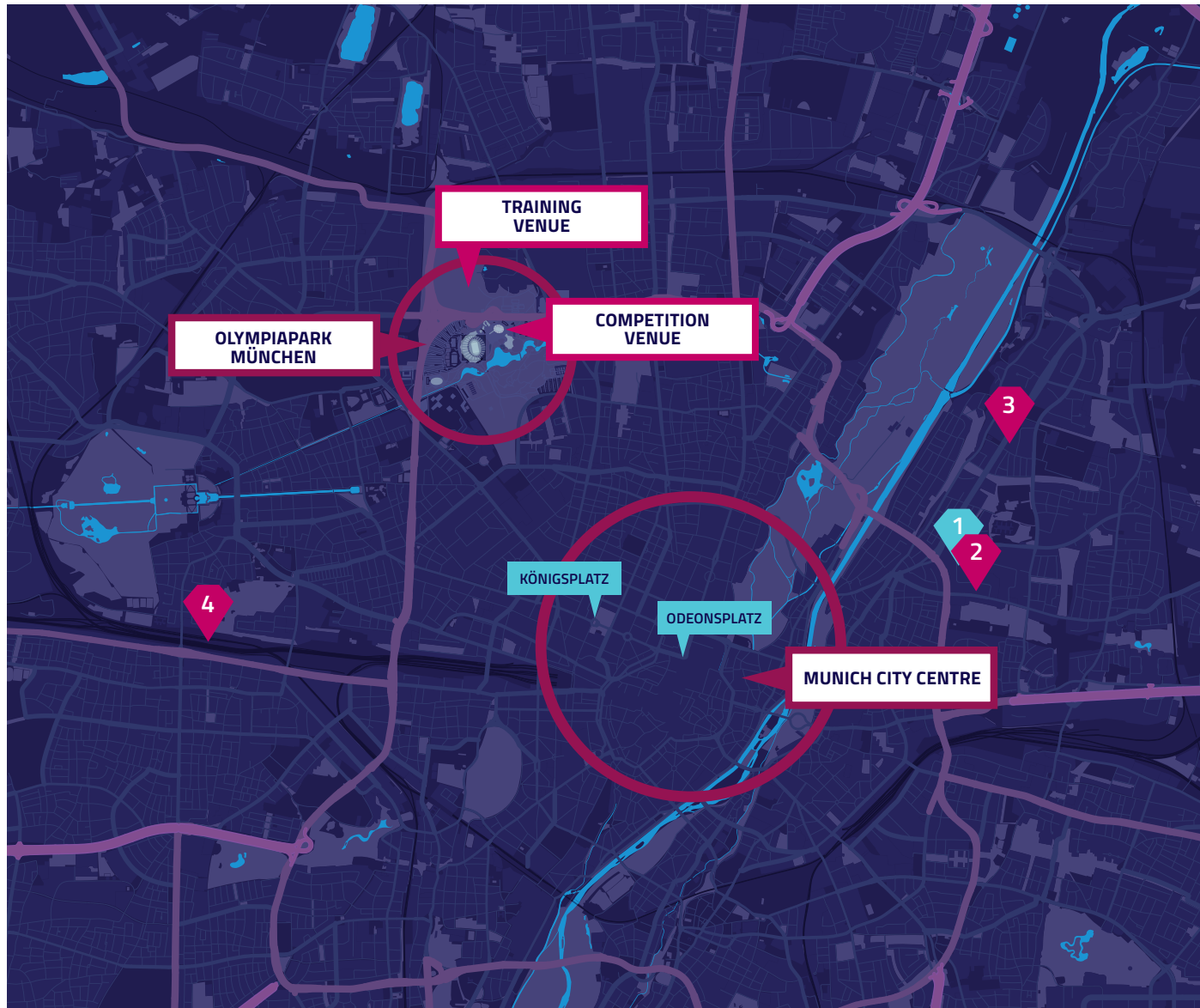
ACCOMMODATION FOR MEDIA

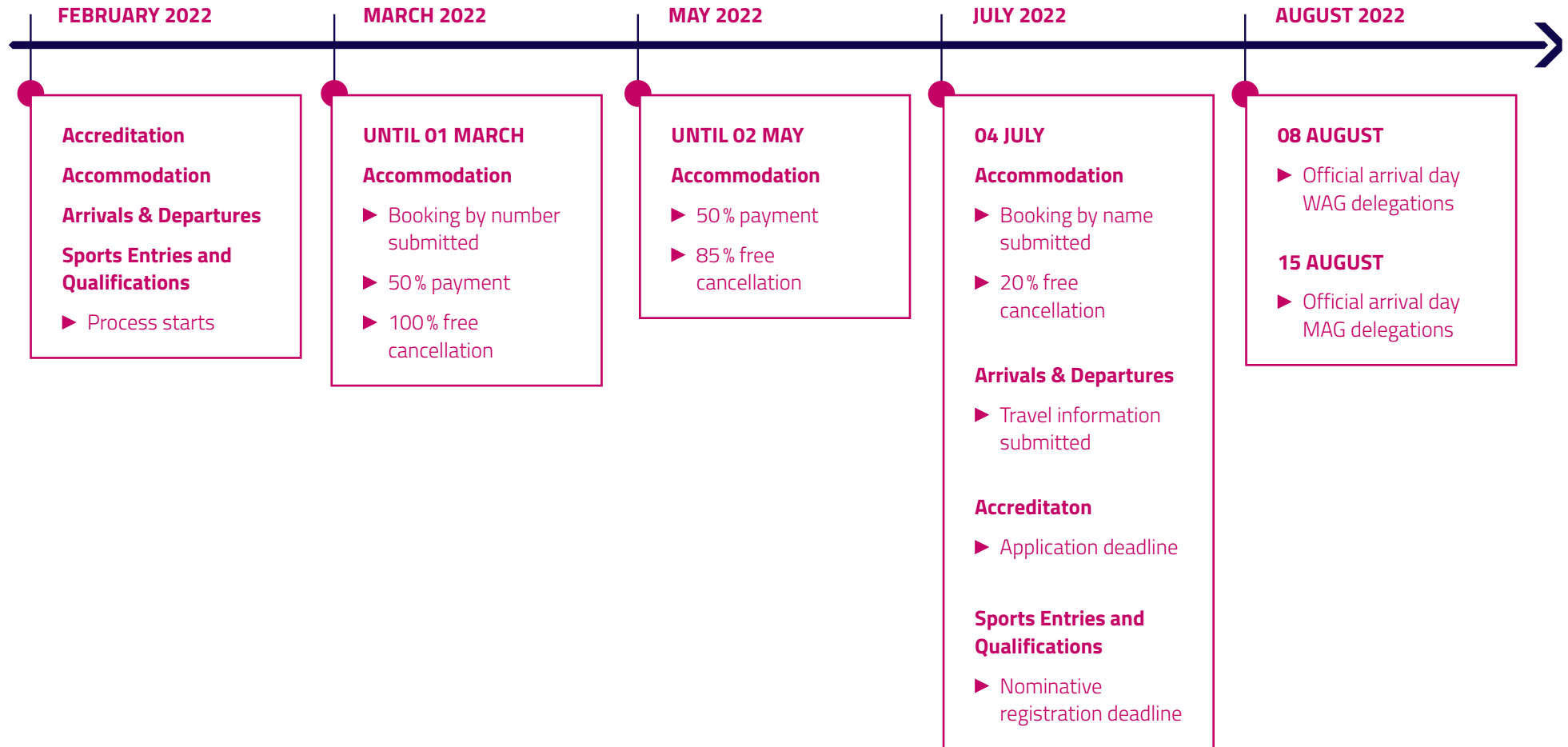

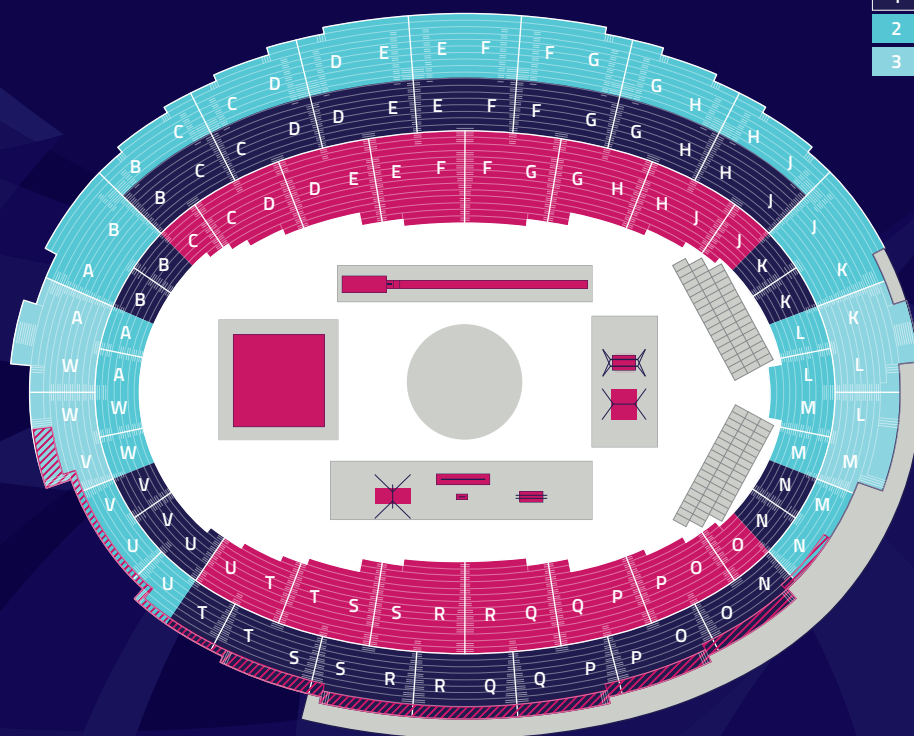
