

MAG and WAG Mix Pair Final (MPF) - Competition Format

Qualification

Qualification for Mix Pair Final (MPF) will be from the MAG and WAG Qualification

One (1) Male & One (1) Female Gymnast from each Federation.

The scores of the highest ranked Male gymnast on FX, PB & HB PLUS the highest ranked Female gymnast on VT, BB & FX from the QC will be added together to determine the Total Mixed Pair Result for each Federation.

Qualification is by NAME and not by Federation.

The Best 16 Mixed Pairs will qualify from the QC for the Mixed Pair Final

Mix Pair Final (MPF)

Round 1 & 2

- All 16 Teams Compete in Rounds 1 & 2
- MAG & WAG Gymnasts will compete independently of each other in Rounds 1 & 2.
- Gymnasts can choose the order on which they compete on the relevant Apparatus, for example: -
 - o A WAG gymnast may decide to compete on Beam in Round 1 and chose to compete on Vault in Round 2
- An Apparatus cannot be repeated in Round 1 or Round 2
- If a Gymnast choses to compete on Vault in either Round 1 or Round 2 – Only 1 Vault is required.
- At the end of Round 2, the 4 Mixed Pairs with the **Highest Total Score** will qualify for “Round 3 – The Semi Finals”.

Round 3 – The Semi Finals

- Rank 1 compete against Rank 4 and Rank 2 compete against Rank 3
- No Scores are carried forward from Rounds 1 & 2 (All Mixed Pairs start from “0”)
- In Round 3, gymnasts must compete on an Apparatus they have not yet competed on.
- At the end of Round 3: -
 - o The 2nd placed Mixed Pair in Group 1 will compete against the 2nd placed Mixed Pair in Group 2 in “Round 4 – The Bronze Medal Final”.
 - o The Winners of Group 1 will compete against the Winners of Group 2 in “Round 5 – The Final”.

Round 4 – The Bronze Medal Final

- This Round will decide the winners of the Bronze Medal.
- No scores are carried forward from Round 3 (All Mixed Pairs start from “0”).
- The gymnasts can choose freely which apparatus they would like to compete on.
- If a Gymnast chose to compete on Vault in Round 4 – 2 Vaults are required with Junior Rules applying for WAG.
For MAG 2 Vaults are required. The Vault score will be the average of the 2 Vault score.
- The Mixed Pair with the **Highest Total Score** at the end of Round 4 will determine the winner of the Bronze Medal.

Round 5 – The Final

- This Round will decide the Silver & Gold Medal Winners.
- No scores are carried forward from Round 3 (All Mixed Pairs start from “0”).
- The gymnasts can choose freely which apparatus they would like to compete on.
- If a Gymnast chose to compete on Vault in Round 5 – 2 Vaults are required with Junior Rules applying for WAG.
For MAG 2 Vaults are required. The Vault score will be the average of the 2 Vault score.
- The Mixed Pair with the **Highest Total Score** at the end of Round 5 will determine the ranking for Silver & Gold Medals.

Tie-Break Rule

In case of a tie in points at any place to qualify for, or during any phase of the MPF, the ranking will be determined by respecting the following criteria:

- The pair with the highest sum of E-Scores across the apparatus in the phase of competition prevails
- The pair with the highest sum of best single E-Score, one MAG plus one WAG across the apparatus in the phase of competition prevails
- The pair with the single highest E-Score MAG or WAG across the apparatus in the phase of competition prevails
