

European Gymnastics Online Competition “Perfect 10” in Men’s Artistic Gymnastics

The European Gymnastics Online Competition “Perfect 10” in Men’s Artistic Gymnastics will take place with a reduced Code of Points format. The emphasis is on well-performed, high-level gymnastics.

The format of the exercise construction is as follows:

- The exercise start value (SV) will be the value of the best 4 elements in the exercise (irrespective of element group) plus the value of the dismount (on FX last tumble pass).
- The maximum SV for an exercise will be 2.0. For example, if the 4 best elements are value D, E, E and D and the dismount is C; element values add up to 2.1 but SV is 2.0.
- A gymnast who performs an exercise with SV 2.0 (or more) will have their exercise judged from 10.0; a gymnast with SV 1.8 will have their exercise judged from 9.8 etc.. So, the maximum total score a gymnast can receive for their exercise 10.0; “Perfect 10”.
- If an exercise has less than 5 recognised elements, 2.0 will be deducted per missing element from the final score.
- There is no element group requirement for elements other than dismount. No connection bonus or stick bonus will be applied to this competition.
- The specific D Score neutral deductions for Floor Exercise and Still Rings will apply to this competition.
- On vault, only one vault will be performed. A gymnast that performs a vault with Code of Points SV of 4.4 or more will have their vault judged from 10.0. A vault performed with a SV less than 4.4 will have the difference deducted from 10.0. For example, performing a SV 3.6 vault would have the vault judged from 9.2.
- Execution deductions will be made in accordance with the 2025-2028 MAG CoP.
- Ties will not be broken. In the case of a tie in the final, the prize money concerned will be shared.
