INVITATION TO THE TEAMGYM JUDGES' COURSES

May 17th-18th (online) and June 13th-15th in Vienna (AUT) June 7th-8th (online) and July 4th-6th in Inverclyde (GBR)

Dear TeamGym Friends,

The European Gymnastics Technical Committee for TeamGym, have the pleasure in inviting you to two TeamGym Judges' courses during May-July 2025. A third course is also planned for late 2025 or early 2026 and a separate invitation will be sent later for this course. Each course consists of both online and face-to-face sessions (in total two weekends). Further details about the courses will be provided after the registration deadline.

The new Code of Points is currently being finalised and will be distributed at the end of March 2025.

Candidates who successfully pass the judges' course will receive the European Gymnastics TeamGym Brevet for the cycle 2025-2028. Course results and category level for both courses will be available in mid-July.

Please note that candidates for the TeamGym TC election at the 2025 European Gymnastics Congress must hold the European Gymnastics TeamGym brevet category 1 or 2. Therefore, attending one of the two first courses would be necessary for any prospective candidates for the European Gymnastics TeamGym Technical Committee 2025-2028.

Participants

Each course has initially a maximum number of places (2) per federation. Please wait for your application to be confirmed before committing to travel plans. Additional places to either of the courses may be applied for. Federations will be contacted directly after the deadline to inform them about the allocated places.

Language

The courses will be held in English.

The nearest airport is Glasgow International Airport (GLA) located about 40 km from Inverclyde. Transfer by taxi (appr. £65 for four people one-way) or public transport. After the registration deadline, the local organising committee will assist in booking transfer by taxi and propose sharing of taxis depending on flight schedules.

Accommodation is optional and has been pre-booked at the Inverclyde National Centre.

Option 1

Accommodation in a single room €170 for 2 nights per person, including breakfast, from Friday July 4th to Sunday July 6th. Additional nights and meals may be requested for and are subject to availability.

Option2

Accommodation in a shared twin room €115 for 2 nights per person, including breakfast, from Friday July 4th to Sunday July 6th. Additional nights and meals may be requested for and are subject to availability.

For both courses, the reservation of accommodation is made at the same time as registration for the courses.

Homework assignments

All participants will receive a confirmation with detailed information on how to prepare for the course. The TeamGym Code of Points 2025-2028 is available for download in late March on our website https://www.europeangymnastics.com/page/rules.

All candidates must do mandatory training between the online and live courses. The homework may be counted towards the exam.

The sessions in **Vienna** and Inverclyde will focus on practising judging on video (all apparatus) and the exam.

DEFINITIVE AND NOMINATIVE APPLICATIONS

By submitting a provisional and/or definitive and/or nominative application, you accept that data you input will be transmitted to and saved by European Gymnastics. NF has access to its data at all times in order to amend it.

DATA PROCESSING

Data submitted to European Gymnastics and transferred to the LOC may be used for the following purposes:

- Preparation of the organisation of this event
- List of athletes and coaches designated by name
- List of delegations and accompanying persons designated by name

DUTY OF EUROPEAN GYMNASTICS

European Gymnastics shall supply the most recent data to their LOC on time and on a regular basis.

DUTY OF THE LOC

The LOC undertakes not to disseminate to its own clients the data submitted by European Gymnastics and NFs, to use the information exclusively for the event, to respect the retention/erasure period provided and to take any useful measure to safeguard the information in its possession.

RETENTION OF INFORMATION IN ORDER TO PREPARE THE EVENT

The LOC is entitled to retain for a 6-month period the information related to the entries and the organisation of the event.

After this deadline, all information received shall be erased except for the accounting data such as invoicing. The legal deadline of the host country shall apply.

PUBLICATION OF PHOTOS AND/OR MOVING IMAGES

By submitting a provisional and/or definitive and/or nominative application through the NF, all participants agree to be filmed, televised, photographed, identified and otherwise recorded during the event under the conditions and for the purposes now or hereafter authorised by European Gymnastics in relation with the promotion of the event.
