2.2 Competitions Format

The FIG requirements will be applied for all phases of competitions.

Event ID: **17268**

According to FIG TR 2023, the 2023 European Championships is a qualifying event for the World Championships. For details, see the FIG TR 2023 ***“Qualifications Pathway to the World Championships”***.

No late registrations will be accepted after the Definitive Registration / after the Drawing of Lots (i.e. the gymnasts will not be allowed to compete), however, a NF who has registered a Team is authorized to add gymnasts to the number declared at the Definitive Registration, up to the maximum quota allowed (Ref. FIG Technical Regulations - Section 2 - Art. 6 - Registration Changes)

MAG – Qualifying Competition

Qualifying Competition incl. Team Final, plus qualification for All-Around Final and Apparatus Finals.

For MAG Senior Team consists of 3 - 5 gymnasts, of which up to 4 compete on each apparatus. The 3 best scores on each apparatus are added together to make the total score for the Team on that apparatus.

MAG Federations who compete with a Senior Team may bring a 6th gymnast to participate as an individual apparatus specialist. This gymnast may compete on a maximum of 3 apparatus. The apparatus on which the 6th gymnast competes must be declared by the Federation in the nominative entry and cannot subsequently be changed.

WAG – Qualifying Competition

Qualifying Competition incl. Team Final, plus qualification for All-Around Final and Apparatus Finals

Each NF can enter 5 WAG gymnasts, of which a maximum of 4 WAG gymnasts compete on each apparatus.

MAG & WAG – Individual All Around Final

The 24 gymnasts with the highest ranking obtained in the qualifying competition will qualify for the Individual All Around Final. A maximum of 2 gymnasts per National Federation are allowed. 3 reserve gymnasts will be designated.

MAG & WAG – Apparatus Finals

The 8 highest ranked gymnasts in the qualifying competition per apparatus will qualify for the Apparatus Finals. A maximum of 2 gymnasts per National Federation are allowed. 3 reserve gymnasts for each final are designated.







2.2.1 Qualifying Competition (QC)

- The starting order of the competition is made according to the drawing of lots carried out on **the 21st of March 2023** by the official representatives of European Gymnastics.
- If a National Federation reduces the number of participating gymnasts or apparatus after the nominative entries, European Gymnastics/TCs have the right to modify the starting order in order to ensure the best possible running of the competition. The information about the modification of the starting order will be advised during the orientation meeting.
- The starting order for the QC will be published on the European Gymnastics website.
- For the Team Final Ranking, the top 3 scores of the Team on each Apparatus count towards the Team Total.









2.2.3 Apparatus Finals (AF)

- The starting order for the Apparatus Finals will be according to the draw carried out by the MTC and WTC of European Gymnastics.





- If more than 8 gymnasts are qualified in one Apparatus Final, another drawing of lots will take place, to reflect the number of qualified gymnasts. If a gymnast competes in two (or more) successive Apparatus Finals and medals in the preceding Final (thus reducing the gymnasts' opportunity to return to the warmup hall prior to the next Final), the TC will adjust the start order, if necessary.

2.3 Tie Breaking Rules

In case of a tie at any position at the end of each competition, the tie breaking rules set out in FIG/TR will apply.

2.4 Changes of the Starting Order

If a qualified gymnast is unable to take part in the AAF or AF competition, then they can be replaced by the next gymnast from their federation, on the condition that their result is better than that of the first reserve. This new gymnast will take the starting position of the gymnast they replace.

Withdrawals / Replacements of gymnasts for medical reasons will be accepted in accordance with the FIG/TR provided that the above-mentioned conditions are met. These forms should be submitted to

2.5 Touch warm-up during competition

Warm-up times according to the FIG rules.

- QC, AAF & AF on the podium.
- In Apparatus Finals, the first 4 gymnasts will warm-up and compete followed by the remaining 4 gymnasts warm-up and compete.
- Prior to the start of the AF Competition, a timed/controlled warm-up period of one hour is afforded to the gymnasts on the Podium. This warm-up will end 30 minutes before the start of the competition.

2.6 Access to the competition area

Gymnasts are permitted to return to the warm-up hall during Podium Training & / Competitions, without any special approval, in order to share the designated stretching area and the apparatus. Priority will nevertheless always be given to any gymnasts warming-up for the following subdivision. Therefore, permission will be required from any federation(s) warming-up on the Apparatus before the gymnasts coming from the Competition Hall may use a specific apparatus. Gymnasts will be fully responsible to return to the competition hall when required in order to perform their routine on time.

Concerning the presence of the coaches and medical team on the podium, the following provisions will apply:

- For full Teams in the QC, 2 coaches are allowed (WAG – 1 must be female)
- For Federations with Individual Gymnasts in the QC, **ONLY** 1 coach is allowed regardless of the number of Individuals (WAG – Male / Female)
- For Federations with Individual Gymnasts in the AAF and AF, 1 coach per gymnast is allowed (WAG - Male / Female).
- For all competitions, 1 team medical person per discipline and per National Federation is allowed

2.7 Use of electronic devices (European Gymnastics/TR)

During the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions (which is defined as starting the moment the first gymnast enters the field of play and ending the moment the last score is publicly displayed):

- Judges on the field of play are absolutely prohibited from using cellular phones / tablets and any other kind of electronic communication devices.
- Other delegation members (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff) are prohibited from using cellular phones and any other kind of electronic communication devices. However, gymnasts are allowed to listen to music (with earphones and on a sound level which is not observable for surrounding persons). It is also allowed to other delegation members to take photos (but no videos), without flash and not interrupting the running of the competition.
- If these rules are violated, the persons concerned will receive a verbal warning.
- If this behaviour is repeated after a written warning is issued, those persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition.
- The Superior Jury is responsible for deciding these disciplinary measures.
- Appeals against these decisions have to be submitted to the Jury of Appeal whose decision is final.

2.8 Award ceremonies

The award ceremonies will take place on the podium, immediately after the competition, or during the competition for AF, according to the schedule and will be organised as follows:

- For competition TF MAG and WAG Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium (incl. coaches)
- For competition AAF MAG Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- For competition AAF WAG Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium
- For competition AF MAG and WAG Gold, Silver and Bronze medallists on podium

According to the FIG/TR, gymnasts have to wear their national tracksuit during award ceremonies.

According to the FIG/TR for the organisation of ceremonies, the participation in the award ceremonies is compulsory. Gymnasts that are absent for unjustified reasons will be disqualified.

2.9 SmartScoring Shooting Star Award

The SmartScoring Shooting Star Award will take place on Friday, April 14th after the WAG AAF and prior to the medal award ceremony.

2.10 Apparatus

The apparatus supplier of this European Championships is Gymnova.

Additional landing mats for all apparatus will be provided by the apparatus supplier in the warm up halls and for podium training. In addition, the federations are allowed to bring small protection mats /pads / coverings only. These mats / pads / coverings (e.g. carpet mats, beam protection pad) must not be thicker than 5cm and not bigger than 1.50m x 1m. These mats / pads / coverings can be used during (podium) training and warm up, but not for the touch warm up.

2.11 Scoring and distribution of results

After each competition, the results will be provided on the Internet on the following web site: www.europeangymnastics.com. In addition, it will be sent to the Heads of Delegation by e-mail. At the end of the competition all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores for all competitions.

2.12 Competitions numbers (Bib)

Two (2) sets of competition numbers will be provided to the Head of Delegation by the LOC at accreditation. The numbers must be firmly attached to the competition attire throughout the entire competition.

2.13 New elements

New elements should be submitted as soon as possible by e-mail to the Presidents of the Superior Jury, but no later than 24 hours before the commencement of podium training. A technical drawing and a video must be attached to the e-mail.

2.14 Written exercises / WAG only

Submission of the gymnasts' routines in symbol notation is optional (to be e-mailed or directly given to the Judges' Responsible, Fabienne Ringler: ringlerfabienne@gmail.com).

2.15 Anti-doping control

Any doping is prohibited. An anti-doping control can be requested at any time. Anti-doping controls will be made as per Anti-Doping Control Regulations of FIG and WADA.

3.3 The Apparatus Jury




The WTC and MTC reserve the right to adapt, if necessary, the composition of the Judge's panels according to the situation.

All registered judges must hold the FIG judges brevet (15th cycle). To be allowed to judge the judges must have taken part in the judges' instructions, in the drawing of lots and in the briefings preceding the competitions. In case there is an insufficient number of judges from the participating National Federations, the European Gymnastics MTC/WTC will decide the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

3.3.1 D-jury

- The D1 judges were nominated by the European Gymnastics/TC's.
- The D2 judges were drawn on 3rd February 2023 by the European Gymnastics/TC's after the definitive inscription of the National Federations, according with the category of the Judges.
- D Judges are permitted to attend all Training sessions.
- D1- and D2 Judges remain the same throughout the entire competition and are detailed as follows:

3.3.2 E Jury

- The E judges will be decided by the drawing of lots on site.
- The E-jury consists of Seven (7) E-Judges. The final E-score will be determined from the average of the three middle scores.
- All entered judges must be available until the drawing of lots for the last competition of the respective European Championship. Exceptions will be managed by the President of the European Gymnastics WTC or MTC.
- For AF, a Federation whose gymnast has qualified for an Apparatus Final (including 1st & 2nd Reserve) will as a result, not have their judge included in the Judges Draw for the concerned Apparatus.
- Cat 4 judges, if present, are only allowed to judge line and time.
- As a reminder and according to the European Gymnastics / TR, the function of a judge cannot be combined with any other function.
- E-judges are only permitted to attend the Training sessions of their National Federation.

3.4 Judges' instruction and drawing of lots.

- According to the European Gymnastics / TR, the presence of the Judges at the Judges' instruction is mandatory. If a Judge does not arrive on time and as a result misses the Judges Instruction, she / he will be excluded from judging.
- The Judges' instruction will be held in person and in English. In the event the Judges instruction is switched to an Online instruction, Judges should ensure they bring their Tablet or Laptop to the Championships as a back-up.
- The Judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the Judges' instruction by one of the host Federation's Judges.

3.5 Inquiries of the score

- European Gymnastics applies the relevant TR/FIG Article.
- The detailed procedure is laid down in the Technical Regulations of the FIG.
- If the inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD), at a later date and must be paid within one month.

4.2 Orientation meeting

- Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the Federation of Euro €1,000.

- When attending Podium Training the E-Judges can either sit in the stands or on the FOP.

4.5 Accreditation

The accreditation office will be located at the competition venue. Upon accreditation, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative must provide the following to the LOC:
