2.2 Competition Format

The FIG regulations will be applied for all phases of competitions.

Event ID: 18085

After the drawing of lots (**on 11.04.2025**) no additional gymnasts can be registered.

Senior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition for Rhythmic Gymnastics Cross Battles and Apparatus Finals

1-2 gymnasts per NF

The gymnasts present **minimum 4 and maximum 8 exercises** with the apparatus according to the FIG program for the respective year. A gymnast may participate in 1 – 4 exercises

If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present 4 exercises.

Qualification for the AA Cross-Battles – the best 4 scores count (max. 2 gymnasts per NF).

Cross Battles Senior Individuals

- Best 16 gymnasts from the qualification all-around ranking, *maximum 2 gymnasts per NF*.
- Knock-out competition in 4 stages: best 16 / best 8 / best 4 / fight for medals (3rd & 4th and 1st & 2nd).
- The gymnasts present exercises according to the graphic on the following page.
- The winner of the Cross Battles is awarded with the title "European Cup Champion".
- A presentation of the 2 gymnasts takes place before each battle.

Apparatus Finals Ranking Senior Individuals

Separate apparatus finals for Senior RGI will not take place. The best 3 Senior Individuals, Maximum 1 gymnast per NF, will be awarded medals per apparatus from the qualification competition.

Senior Groups (5 Ribbons, 3 Balls & 2 Hoops)

Qualifying competition

Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus, according to the FIG program for the respective year.

- The All-Around competition is a qualifying competition for the AA Cross Battles and the Apparatus finals.

Apparatus Finals

Separate apparatus finals for Senior RGG will not take place. The best 3 Senior Groups with each apparatus (5 ribbons; 3 Balls & 2 Hoops) will be awarded medals per apparatus from the qualification competition.

Cross Battles Senior Groups

- Best 6 Groups from the qualification all-around ranking.
- Knock-out competition in 2 stages: best 6 / best 3 fight for medals (1st & 2nd & 3rd).
- The winner of the Cross Battles is awarded with the title "European Cup Champion".
- A presentation of the 2 groups (3 groups in the medals round) takes place before each battle.

Junior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition with team ranking

- 1 - 4 gymnasts per NF.
- The gymnasts present in total 4 exercises with the 4 apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year.
- One gymnast may participate with 1 - 4 exercises.
- If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, the gymnast has to present 4 exercises with all 4 apparatus and can qualify for the Apparatus Finals.
- NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking.
- Team ranking: The combined results of all 4 scores.
- The first ranked Junior Team will be awarded with the title "Junior European Cup Team Champion".

Apparatus Finals

- Finals per apparatus with 8 best gymnasts of the qualifying competition.
- Maximum 1 gymnast per NF per final.
- The first ranked gymnast of each final is awarded with the title "Junior European Cup Champion".

Junior Groups (5 Hoops - 5 Clubs)

Qualifying competition with All-Around ranking

- Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 exercises of 2 different apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year. The results will be combined for the all-around ranking for groups who participate with 2 routines.
- The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus finals.
- NF may also participate with only 1 exercise. Groups with 1 exercise can qualify for the Apparatus Final.
- The winner of the All-Around competition is awarded with the title "Junior European Cup Groups All-

Around Champion “.

Apparatus Finals

- 2 finals with the best 8 groups per apparatus of the qualifying competition.
- The first ranked group in each final is awarded with the title “Junior European Cup Champion “.

Tie break rules

RGI Junior, RGG Junior & RGG Senior: The FIG tie break rules in force of the World Championships are applied.

If with these a tie cannot be broken at any stage of the Senior RGG all-around cross battles, the highest group in the AA qualification (using the tie break rule for qualification to AA Final from the WCh) will proceed to the next stage. If there is still a tie, a draw will be made.

RGI Senior: Olympic Games tie-break rules for AA Final in force are applied.

If with these a tie cannot be broken at any stage of the Senior RGI all-around cross battles, the highest ranked gymnast in the qualification (using the tie-break rules for Qualification for AA Final of the OG) will proceed for the next stage. If there is still a tie a draw will be made.

For both Cross Battles (RGI and RGG Senior): If there is a tie at the medal stage (last battle) and the tie cannot be broken with these tie break rules, the gymnasts will share the same position and the prize money concerned will be split equally between the two contenders.

2.3 Access to the competition venue

Only accredited persons (please refer to article 5 in the event directives for participation right & accreditations) have access to the competition venue.

2.4 Use of electronic devices

During the duration of official European Gymnastics competitions (which is defined as starting the moment the first gymnast enters the field of play and ending the moment the last score is publicly displayed):

- Judges on the field of play are absolutely prohibited from using mobile phones / tablets and any other kind of electronic communication devices.
- Other delegation members (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff) are prohibited from using mobile phones and any other kind of electronic communication devices. However, gymnasts are allowed to listen to music (with earphones and on a sound level which is not observable for surrounding persons). It is also allowed to other delegation members to take photos (but no videos), without flash and not interrupting the running of the competition.
- If these rules are violated, the persons concerned will receive a verbal warning.
- If this behaviour is repeated after a written warning is issued, those persons concerned will be excluded for the rest of the competition.
- The Superior Jury is responsible for deciding these disciplinary measures.

2.5 Ceremonies and Awarding

2.5.1 Award ceremonies

All award ceremonies will take place after each block of finals. They will be carried out in accordance with the European Gymnastics Directives for Ceremonies. On the podium, awards will only be presented to the gymnasts ranked from 1st to 3rd place.

- For the junior team award ceremony, **1** coach is allowed on the podium.
- Please ensure that your Federation's medallists are in time for the line-up prior to the ceremonies.
- **All gymnasts & coaches must wear the official tracksuit.**
- The participation of the medallists in the award ceremonies is compulsory. All gymnasts that are

absent for unjustified reasons will be disqualified.

2.5.2 Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place on 01.05.2025 at 15:30 in the MGA.

2.6 Apparatus

The apparatus supplier of this edition of the European Cup is Spieth (color: beige). A total of 9 carpets + additional stretching area will be available.

2.7 Scoring and distribution of results

For each competition, start lists and results will be provided on www.europeangymnastics.com. In addition, they will be sent to the heads of delegation by e-mail. At the end of the championships the head of delegations will receive by e-mail a complete set of results including the judges' individual scores for all competitions.

2.8 Control of the Apparatus

All hand apparatus must be FIG certified and must respect the dimensions of the FIG Apparatus Norms. Random checks on the FIG and Manufacturers' Logos will be carried out at any time during the Event. Any apparatus which is not according to the regulations will be refused or its' use will be penalized (even if that apparatus had been accepted for a prior competition).

2.9 Music

The music has to be uploaded on delegation.gymdata.online not later than March, 27th 2025. The login information has been sent by the LOC to each federation after the definitive registration deadline.

Musics have to be uploaded in the following format:

File format: .mp3

Name of file must contain:

The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country)

The first and last name of the individual competitor

The category (individual/group);

The apparatus

The Junior or Senior (Example: AZE_AGHAMIROVA_Zohra_Senior_Ind._ball.mp3)

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key for their training sessions and in case of a technical problem.

Each Federation will also have to confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports.

At the accreditation, the Heads of delegation have to hand in the Music Release form (appendix 2) which you will receive together with the work plan.

The authorized sound level in the training and competition halls is limited to 80 dB resp. 1000 Hertz (Hz).

2.10 Anti-doping controls

Anti-doping controls may take place at any time. FIG Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Code valid at the time of the event are applicable.

3. THE JURY

3.1 Judges' panels

Each NF may send RGI and/or RGG FIG brevetted judge(s) category 1, 2, 3, 4. **All judges must have a currently valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, in the respective discipline RGI and/or RGG.**

If a federation does not enter a judge as listed above, a fine of EUR 2'000 - per missing judge must be paid to the LOC, to cover costs for the invitation of a neutral judge instead.

Each NF may present one (1) qualified judge with a valid international brevet for each category (Individual and/or Group) in which they have competitors.

The selection of judges is made by draw:

- For the 1st positions per Jury (starting from D, A, E), priority is given to the judges with the highest category.
- D Judges are drawn among the judges with cat. 1 or 2
- Reserve Judges are drawn among the judges cat. 1 or 2
- A, E, Tand L Judges are drawn among the remaining judges cat. 1, 2 or 3.
- Judges are drawn during the judges' briefing before the beginning of each phase of competition.

In Apparatus Finals, only judges whose NFs do not have competitors, nor a No 1 reserve gymnast taking part, may be called upon to judge.

If there are insufficient judges, the TC decides the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

3.2 Superior Jury

The Ad-interim TC President Ms. Eliso Bedoshvili functions as President of the Superior Jury. Ms. Hristiana Todorova functions as assistant.

3.3 Drawing of Lots of the Judges

All judges have to be present during all competition phases for the categories in which they are registered.

3.4 Judges' instruction

Judges Instructions will take place on Wednesday, April 30th at 17:00 – 18:00.

3.5 Code of Ethics

Any close family relative to a competitive gymnast may not judge that gymnast or this group. If a conflict should or could appear, the European Gymnastics Technical Delegate is to be informed, so that appropriate action can be taken.

3.6 Inquiries of the Score

- European Gymnastics applies the relevant FIG TR article in which the detailed procedure is laid down.
- If an inquiry is refused, the amount will be invoiced by European Gymnastics (in Euro, not in USD) and must be paid within one month upon receipt of the invoice.

4.2 Orientation meeting & Welcome Reception

- The Orientation meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 30th at 19:00 in the competition venue followed by a welcome reception
- Max. 2 persons per delegation can participate.
- The presence of the participating National Federations at the Orientation meeting is mandatory.
- Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the Federation of Euro €1,000.

4.3 Training Information

- The training takes place at the times published in this workplan. A detailed training schedule will be provided to the participating National Federations.
- The delegations are obliged to respect the training schedules.
- Access to the training halls is limited to the nations concerned and persons having the according accreditations.
- After the official training in the competition hall, the Heads of Delegation have to confirm with a form (appendix 3), that the music tracks of their gymnasts are correct.

The official trainings start on April 30th, 2025. If any delegation needs training on non-official days before, the LOC can provide it at extra cost.

4.4 Photos of the gymnasts

- Before the start of the official podium training photos of each gymnast and group must be taken for the gymnasts' presentation during the competition.
- Gymnasts must wear their official tracksuit.
- The pictures will be taken at Green Room (-2).

4.5 Accreditation

The accreditation office will be located at the competition venue. Upon accreditation, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative must provide the following to the LOC:

- The passports of all delegation members.
- The medical insurance for all delegation members.
- Proof of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC (accommodation, meals);

- confirm the accuracy of the Music which was uploaded on delegation.gymdata.online
- Submission of e-mail address of one responsible person during the event
- Departure confirmation

4.8 Transportation

International Transportation

The participating Federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation takes a cancellation insurance for their international transportation.

4.11 Safeguarding

A safe environment for all participants is a top priority at the 2025 RG European Cup.
