1. COVID-19 measures

- These European Championships will be organised following the European Gymnastics COVID-19 guidelines, please see Appendix 1.
- A proof of **vaccination or negative PCR test** result (done max. 72h before arrival), readable in English, must be provided for all participants at accreditation latest.
- Only the EU approved vaccines are allowed at the event (<u>BioNTech/Pfizer</u>, <u>Moderna</u>, <u>AstraZeneca</u> and <u>Janssen Pharmaceutica NV</u>. This means that the following are **NOT** valid: Sputnik, Chinese vaccines, Canadian vaccine and other domestically produced local vaccines.
- National Federations are requested to send for each delegation member a health insurance confirmation
 document, valid in Italy and stating that it covers the consequences of Covid19; as for the Covid-19 related
 quarantine costs, if it is not included in the insurance coverage, the federation must confirm in writing
 to assume the financial risk themselves. The insurance confirmation must be provided at accreditation.
- FIG's IMSSA insurance covers Covid19 as illness (including all treatments, possible repatriation etc.) for gymnasts and judges. However, an eventual needed quarantine period (or need to stay on site as accompanying person) of a "not ill" person is **NOT** covered. The national federation must take care of the appropriate coverage and financial planning themselves. The LOC is offering an insurance for the duration of the event (see point 5.11).
- It is the responsibility of the NF to verify the up-to-date travel information before departure to Italy with the LOC and on www.viaggiaresicuri.it
- A second mandatory quick test will be done on site during the week (at the charge of the NF). This test will cost €25 per test and per person. Payment will have to be done during accreditation in cash or by credit card.
- If you need a quick or PCR test to go back home (€60), please fill in the appendix 2 and give it to the LOC at accreditation.
- Face masks (only chirurgical not in tissue) are mandatory for all delegation member! Please bring enough face masks for all your team.
- Fill in the form in the European Gymnastics Covid19 guidelines and give it to the LOC at accreditation.
- All side events such as the welcome reception, round table, banquet have been cancelled.
- Each Head of Delegation is to be responsible for its own team.
- Spectators (maximum capacity will be updated later according to Italian Government decisions) are allowed to enter the Arena. Spectators must come with a proof of vaccination or a PCR test not older than 72h and wear a face mask at all time.
- If any accredited person does not follow the established Covid-19 prevention procedures, the accreditation card will be removed and the person must leave the venue.

1.1 Responsibilities

• In order to maintain the safety for everyone participating in the event it is the responsibility of the NF that all of their delegation members commit to fully respect the Covid19 guidelines for European Gymnastics events. We are convinced the Covid19 risks can be brought to a minimum with that. The LOC will prepare the necessary arrangements of eventual quarantine / positive Covid19 cases. Nonetheless, the responsibility for eventual quarantine and/or positive Covid19 cases concerning their delegation remains with the NF. This includes the covering of all costs

The maximum number for the Qualifying Round is:

two per category and federation for IM, IW, MP, TR one per category and federation for GR, AD

The top eight of IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, AD Junior / Seniors may participate in the finals.

max. 2 per NF for IM, IW, MP, TR

NB: in accordance with the Technical Regulations of European Gymnastics, the Aerobic Step competition had to be cancelled due to an insufficient number of registrations.

3.3 Team Ranking Juniors and Seniors

- To participate in the Team Ranking, federations must participate with at least one participant in the qualifications of the following categories: Individual Men and/or Individual Women, Mixed Pair, Trio, Group and Aerobic Dance.
- The team ranking list will be established by adding the 5 best rankings obtained during the qualifications in the following categories: Individual Men or Individual Women, Mixed Pair, Trio, Group, Aerobic Dance.
- The NF with the lowest number of points is declared Team European Champion.

Tie breaking rules for the team ranking:

In case of a tie in points at any place in the Team Ranking, the ranking will be determined by the following criteria:

- 1. the best ranked Group
- 2. the best ranked Trio

If there is still a tie, the tie will not be broken.

3.4 Qualifications

- The drawing of lots for **the starting order of the qualifications** took place in Rome, July 8th, 2021 (Appendix A). Please note that the order indicated on the nominative entry form will determine the place of the competitor(s) and the number of the draw (starting list). No changes will be allowed.
- If a National Federation reduces the number of participating gymnasts after the definitive inscriptions, the European Gymnastics/AER-TC has the right to adjust the starting order in order to ensure the best possible running of the competition.
- In case of a tie at any position at the end of the qualification see FIG TR. Sec. 6-3.3
- The order of all categories for JUNIOR competitions in the qualifications will be:

 \circ 1st day: TR / GR / AD \circ 2nd day: IW / IM / MP

- The order of all categories for SENIOR competitions in the qualifications will be:
 - $\begin{array}{ll} \circ & 1^{st} \ day: \ IW \ / \ IM \ / \ MP \\ \circ & 2^{nd} \ day: \ TR \ / \ GR \ / \ AD \end{array}$

3.5 Finals

- The starting order of the finals is made according to the draw of lots carried out in Rome July 8th, 2021, by the official representatives of European Gymnastics (Appendix A).
- The top eight of IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, AD categories are qualified for the final.
- The order of all categories for competitions in the juniors and senior finals will be:
 - o IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, AD
- The list of the finalists, with two reserves, will be distributed to the head of delegation after each qualification.

3.6 Equipment

The apparatus supplier of this edition of the European Championships is Spieth.

The floor colour is grey.

3.7 Scoring and distribution of results

Smart Scoring will provide the official scoring service and management of the start lists, scores and results. All lists and results will be sent by E-mail to the Heads of Delegation (contact info of the HoD will be collected at accreditation for this purpose).

At the end of the European Championships, the results book including the judges' individual scores for all competitions will be sent by e-mail to the Heads of Delegation.

3.8 Award ceremonies

The ceremonies will take place in the competition venue according to the competition schedule. For all award ceremonies gymnasts must wear their **national tracksuits**.

3.9 SmartScoring Shooting Star Award

The SmartScoring Shooting Star Award will take place right after the last award ceremony on **Sunday, September 19**th, **at 18h25** in the Vitrifrigo Arena.

3.10 Athletes' Portraits

A photo of each unit **in national track suite** shall be taken after podium training on Wednesday, September 15th. For this purpose, the athletes are requested to follow the dedicated volunteers to have their pictures taken. These photos will be used by the Scoring company for the display on the screen during the events.

3.11 Access to the competition area

- The competition area is accessible to members of the various juries, competing gymnasts and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of European Gymnastics' Medical Commission, to the official doctor, to the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the gymnasts and coaches during all Competitions.
- Interpreters may not enter the competition area without permission of the President of European Gymnastics AER-TC.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.
- The use of mobile phones or any other electronic communication device by gymnasts, coaches, judges
 or medical staff of the delegations on the field of play is forbidden during the entire duration of all
 European Gymnastics Competitions. If this rule is violated, the concerned persons will receive a
 written warning.

If this behaviour is repeated after the written warning is issued, the concerned person will be excluded for the rest of the competition.

It is the responsibility of the Superior Jury to decide these disciplinary measures.

Appeals against these decisions must be submitted to the Jury of Appeal whose decision is final.

3.12 Music

- All music (National Anthem included) used during the 12th Aerobic Gymnastics European
 Championships must be submitted online via LOC digital platform https://acc.gymresult.it/ by no later than August 24th, 2021.
 - MUSICS must be uploaded in the following file format: .mp3 or .wav
 - NATIONAL ANTHEM has to be uploaded in the following file format: .mp3 or .wav
- If you need help, you can write to the following e-mail address: support@gymresult.it
- Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key of their music for their training sessions and in case of a technical problems.
- Each Federation will also have to confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports.

4.4 Judges' instruction and drawing of lots

All judges must participate in the briefing sessions as described in the Competition Schedule. Short judges' briefings will take place before each competition.

According to the FIG/TR, the presence of the judges to the judges' instruction is mandatory.

The judges' instruction will be held in English.

The judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the judges' instruction, by one of the host federation judges.

4.6 Inquiries procedure

- Inquiries for the difficulty scores only are allowed, provided that they will be made verbally immediately after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the end of the exercise of the following gymnast. For the last gymnast of a rotation, this limit is **one minute** after the score is shown on the scoreboard. The person designated to receive the verbal inquiry will have to note the time of receiving it and this will start the procedure. Only the accredited coaches in the competition area will be entitled to submit an inquiry. Late verbal inquiries will be rejected.
- A federation will not be allowed to complain against a gymnast from another federation.
- The inquiry will have to be confirmed as soon as possible in writing, but within **4 minutes** at the latest after the verbal inquiry and will require an agreement of payment of:
 - o EUR 300.-- for the first complaint
 - o EUR 500.-- for the second complaint and
 - EUR 1'000.-- for the third complaint
- Should the inquiry not be confirmed in writing within 4 minutes, then the procedure will become obsolete.
- Should the final score be higher, this sum will **not** be invoiced by European Gymnastics to the Federation. However, should the final score remain unchanged or be lower, the sum will be invoiced by European Gymnastics.
- Every inquiry will be examined by the Superior Jury and a final decision, which may not be appealed, will be taken at the very latest:
 - At the end of the rotation (group) for the qualifying competitions.
 - Before the score of the following gymnast is shown for the finals.
- The detailed procedure is laid down in the European Gymnastics & FIG Technical Regulations.

5.2 Accreditation

Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations.

For the accreditation process, only the Head of Delegation (and/or his representative) is requested to present him-/herself at the accreditation centre. The following items will be checked there with the Heads of Delegations:

- Passport of all members of the delegations
- Medical insurance covering Covid19 for all delegation members (except for gymnasts and judges)
- Vaccination certificate or PCR-test results for all delegation members
- Pre-Event Health- and Responsibilities Questionnaire (form to be found in the Covid19 guidelines)
- Appendix 2 _ request for covid test for return trip (if necessary)
- Proof of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC
- National anthem and national flag
- Email address and phone number of Head of Delegation
- Departure confirmation

In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation in the online accreditation tool of the LOC (the link and sign in details were sent to the participating delegations by the LOC after the definitive entry's deadline).

The deadline for the photos & passport copies upload (identity colour photo in JPG format, size -45mm x 35mm, resolution: 800x600plx) is **August 24**th, **2021**. Please clearly indicate the corresponding full name (with correct spelling) in the file title.

Each NF must also register the full delegation on the European Gymnastics *GymData Online* registration system by the stated entry deadlines for Definitive & Nominative entry (see point 7 below).

- Guest accreditations are at the charge of the Federation.
- For additional accreditations, we refer to the European Gymnastics Accreditation Rules.

The European Gymnastics Accreditation Rules and Media Rules have to be strictly respected.

5.3 Delegation boxes

The Main Information Desk will operate at the Accreditation Centre of the Vitrifrigo Arena. Information Desks will also be available at the official hotels.

Mailboxes will be set up at the competition venue where the delegations' members can find all necessary information.

No hard copies of any documents (start list, results & etc.) will be available for distribution.

All documents will be sent by e-mail to the responsible person from each delegation provided that the correct

e-mail address was submitted at accreditation.

All the necessary information will also be communicated via WhatsApp group (mobile phone numbers of HoD will be collected for this purpose).

5.4 Orientation Meeting

- The orientation meeting for the Heads of Delegation will take place on Wednesday, September 15th,
 2021, 10h00 11h00 at Grand Hotel Vittoria conference room.
- The presence of the participating Federations at the orientation meeting is <u>mandatory</u>. Due to the Covid-19 situation, only 1 member of the delegation can participate in person.
- The orientation meeting will also be provided on ZOOM if other member of the delegation wishes to join. The Zoom link will be sent onsite to all HoD by email.
- The orientation meeting will be held in English only.
- Unjustified failure to attend will result in a sanction against the federation of Euro 1.000.

5.5 Training information

- The training will start on Wednesday, September 15th and will take place in the training and competition halls.
- A detailed timetable for the warm-up will be handed out to the Heads of delegation upon arrival.
- The timetable of the training and the warm-up of the finalists will be given to the Heads of delegation on Saturday evening 18th of September 2021 for Juniors and Seniors.

5.6 Opening ceremony

The Official Opening Ceremony will be held on Friday September 17th, 16:00 to 16:30

5.7 Medical

The OC will provide the necessary medical services.

Doping Controls

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control can be requested at any time, in accordance with the FIG/European Gymnastics regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA/FIG regulations.

5.10 Transportation

The invited participating Federations must pay for the air travel costs of their delegation members.

European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their travel.

The official arrival airports are: Ancona Airport (AOI - 65 km from Pesaro) or Bologna Airport (BLQ - 155 km from Pesaro). You can also arrive to Pesaro Railway Station by train via Adriatic line.

The travel details must be submitted to the LOC by email to events@esatourgroup.com until August 24th, 2021.

Local Transportation

The LOC will organize return shuttle buses from official hotels to the competition venue (training venue is inside the competition venue) and for all delegations.

Transportation by bus to and from the airports or train station mentioned above are included in the official Pesaro 2021 package price, given that transportation information has been sent in due time.

5.11 Insurance

The Host Federation, the LOC, European Gymnastics and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation. See also insurance related information under point 1 *COVID-19 measures*.

Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC until **August 24th**, **2021.** The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: € 50.- per person for the official event dates.
